

Mission and Outreach News Light House Station


1 Thessalonians 2:7 Instead, we were like young children among you. Just as a nursing mother cares for her children...

This month's mission is Light House Station. This is a new mission that the Mission and Outreach Committee decided to support this month by having a baby bottle collection. The purpose is to sign a baby bottle out, take it home and fill it with either loose change, paper money, even a check or a combination of either. Then the bottle is returned back to the Church for donation. This collection started appropriately on Mother's Day and will end on June 17th. And why is that appropriate?

Light House Station is a maternity home that supports pregnant single women. It is a Christian based mission that offers the following to the women who stay with them: Safe and free housing for up to 6 months after the baby is born, life skills curriculum, goal planning, Biblical counseling and teaching, academic tutoring, and physical, emotional, mental and spiritual support.
